

We are taking online, over-the-phone, and in-person applications for the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

Applications are taken from Nov. 1-Apr. 30.

This program helps qualifying Woodbury County residents pay a portion of their primary heating costs. Assistance is based on several factors, including total



household income, household size, dwelling type, heating fuel type, among others
