Iowa Rent and Utility Assistance Program

The Iowa Rent and Utility Assistance Program (IRUAP) was created with COVID-19 funds to help low-income Iowans pay their rent and utility bills. The Iowa Finance Authority dispersed this funding throughout the pandemic helping families with up to 12 months of assistance. The Iowa Finance Authority announced that they will stop taking applications for this program August 30th, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. THERE HAS NOT BEEN ANY FUNDING ANNOUNCED TO REPLACE THIS PROGRAM.

This will leave a lot of Iowans in a difficult place. No organization in the area has access to the level of funding that this program did. However, if you are in crisis and need help, please call 712-274-1610 and schedule an appointment with one of our outreach workers. We are working hard to help each and every client coming to us for help. We are proud of the role we have played in obtaining rent and utility assistance for the families in our community.
