Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has begun. In fiscal year, 2021, we helped nearly 3,000 households with their energy bills. LIHEAP runs from October 1 through April 30. This is a federally funded program through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. So far this year, we have helped more than 1,600 households, which equals nearly \$800,000 in federal aid to Woodbury County families who need it most.
