Community Action Agency is the ONLY Food Pantry in the area open to the public 40 hours a week. There has been an unprecedented increase in the number of families served in the past six months. The agency provides three to five days' worth of food for residents of Woodbury County.

This past year we have also been providing families with basic personal and household hygiene items (See Below). Depending on the families' needs, it costs roughly \$20 - \$30 to provide an adequate amount of food, toiletries, and household cleaning supplies. Please

Priority Applications for LIHEAP open October 1st!

We are taking online, over-the-phone, and in-person priority applications starting October 1st for the Low–Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

Priority is given to households with at least one individual aged 60 and over **OR** a disabled individual (self-declared). Regular applications will be open November 1 - April 30.

This program helps qualifying Woodbury County residents pay a portion of their primary heating costs. Assistance is based on several factors, including total household income, household size, dwelling type, heating fuel type, among others.

CSBG CARES Funding Ended September 30th.

CARES Act funds provided \$1 billion in supplemental funds to states, territories, and tribes

authorized under the CSBG Act. These funds were intended to address the consequences of increasing unemployment and economic disruption as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Community Action Agency utilized this funding to help families with numerous types of assistance (Ex: car repairs, appliances, work clothes, furniture, transportation, food). This funding helped many Siouxland families throughout the past few years. With it ending September 30th, the agency will be unable to provide assistance to the same extent.
